COMMENTS

A. Rehabilitation Services

- I have no way of determining if recommendations were carried out by the school or home. I am not invited to attend IPP meetings so I am not able to obtain information that way.
- This survey by no means captures the progress and benefit of speech therapy of my clients. A child who did not fully achieve their goal but made leaps and bounds of improvement, shows on your survey as having done poorly - meeting none of their goals.
- I did not track how much students benefitted (recommendations). It would all be subjective from parent/teacher reports.

B. Mental Health Services

- Coordination and teamwork between health and schools needs to be improved.
- Mental Health Therapists for students are a concern. The therapist I know has no commitment to students.
- Thank you - another busy and productive year.
- I find there is a shortage of Mental Health service providers. Many families in rural areas lack transportation so they are unable to access these services. OT and speech services are not always available.
- The numbers reported for goals set and recommendations proposed were done with closed files for this year.
